Sealed Bids for the construction of Modifications to the Village of New Paltz Water Filtration Facility, Contract No. VNP-142 will be received, by the Village of New Paltz, at the office of the Village Clerk, Village of New Paltz Village Hall, 25 Plattekill Avenue, New Paltz, New York until 2:00 PM local time on Thursday, November 30, 2017 at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read. The Project consists of the following: General Construction work consisting of furnishing all materials, equipment and labor necessary to renovate existing potable water filtration plant, including all associated site work, selective demolition, piping, valves, equipment, concrete work, furnishing temporary treatment system, interconnection to existing piping, package filter units and controls, monitoring equipment, instrumentation, data acquisition system, chemical feed equipment, pumps, tanks, miscellaneous metals, disinfection equipment renovation, and miscellaneous work, all as defined in greater detail in the contract documents. Electrical Construction work consisting of furnishing all materials, equipment and labor necessary to complete all underground wire, panels, lighting, outlets, wires, conduits, fixtures, interconnection to existing electrical system, and equipment associated with the water filtration plant, all as defined in greater detail in the Contract Documents.

Bids will be received for separate prime contracts including a General Construction Contract, and an Electrical Contract. Bids shall be on a lump sum, as indicated in the Bid Form.
